

## **God's Presence in Our Lives**

Psalm 139 indicates three things about who God is:

God knows everything about us:

There are things that no other human being knows about you. God knows more than just our thoughts. He also knows why we respond to situations like we do. No one knows you like God does. David said, "you are intimately acquainted with all my ways". (Psalm 139:3)

God is with us constantly:

Our awareness of the awesomeness of God is the greatest way of worshiping him. David worshiped God by describing how unique God is. Only God can be everywhere at the same time. In 24 verses, David writes, "you/your" 25 times. His focus is on God. If God is with us constantly, then he is to be worshiped constantly.

God loves and cares for us even though he knows all about us:

The Bible tells us in Rom 5:8 that "God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us"! David says, "how precious also are Your thoughts to me, O God! How vast is the sum of them! If I should count them, they would outnumber the sand." (Ps 139:17) No matter how wretched we can get, God is always the same! He loves and cares about us!

Instead of worrying and doubting, we can choose to dwell on thoughts of this great God who is always with us, knows all about us, and cares for us.
